

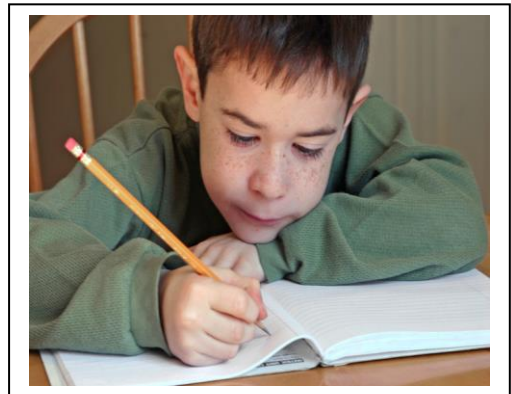
## **SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

Educational support is a vital component to ensure the holistic development of a child and it gives the bright children from the economically weaker sections an opportunity to pursue their education without any break.

The objective of the policy is to award scholarships to the meritorious children belonging to economically weaker sections and affected by HIV/AIDS /leprosy/Tuberculosis and allied diseases.

### **Eligibility**

Scholarship will be awarded to the student who have secured not less than 65% to 70% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.1 Lakh per annum.



### **Conditions for Scholarship**

- a) Scholarship will be given to the students, post metric from Government/Recognised private school/Institute.
- b) Students from BPL families, having the lowest income & deserving shall be given preference in the ascending order.
- c) Scholarships will not be given to more than one student in a family.
- d) The student should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the school/college/university.
- e) Income certificate should be on self-certification basis by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper for self-employed parents and from employer for employed parents.
- f) If a student violates any term & condition of the scholarship, the scholarship may be suspended or cancelled.
- g) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement/certificates, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid shall be recovered.
- h) Course fee / tuition fee/books will be credited to the school's/college's/institution's bank account.
- i) The student obtaining benefits under this scholarship scheme shall not be allowed to avail of benefits under any other scholarship for the same purpose.
