SOME KEY UPDATES

Andhra Pradesh & Telangana

- Developed Water, Sanitaion & Hygiene infrastructure in AP.
- In collaboration with FHI360, LEPRA has started implementing a new project - American Rescue Plan Act for facilitating COVID19 vaccination to the most vulnerable communities.

Bihar

- Completed the shoe technician & physio technician workshop on 28th & 29th Oct at Raxaul, Bihar.
- 15 disability camps were conducted for leprosy affected.
- Mobile footwear unit covered 5 leprosy colonies.

Odisha

- Restarted Morbidity Management & Disability Prevention (MMDP) clinic services in Puri for leprosy and lymphatic filariasis.
- 128 leprosy affected availed services at our referral centres.

Madhya Pradesh

- Facilitated the mental health counselling session as a part of the recently held shoe and physio technician workshop in Raxaul, Bihar.
- 22 prison inmates were tested HIV positive out of the 10,021 tests done. Immediate treatment started.

Research

- Along with GHMC, we started integrated services at Basti Dawakhanas of Medchal for leprosy, lymphatic filariasis and diabetes.
- The hospital management students were provided with sensitisation programme on research & public health system.

Eyecare

• 2,199 cataract surgeries were performed at our eye care hospitals – JNC (Kalahandl) & MNC (Sonepur) in Odisha.

Participated in the half yearly programme review of Odisha programmes (first inperson meeting of colleagues after more than a year due to COVID19 restrictions) & visited JNC in Kalahandi, which has started improving its performance over last few months in extending eye care services to people in remote places of Kalahandi. Happy to share that our Fight, Defeat, Celebrate (FDC) campaign in the last month (October) was successful.

This month's campaign focuses on providing educational scholarship support for children belonging to marginalised & vulnerable communities (click here to support). Participated as a panel member in the Indian Association of Leprologists (IAL) discussions on priorities for leprosy programmes in India along with prominent leprologists of India. Initiated the 'Basti Dawakhanas' along with GHMC for providing services related to leprosy, lymphatic filariasis and diabetes at 52 locations in Medchal.
