LEPRA has absolute clarity as to how incidents and allegations should be handled should they arise, including reporting to the relevant authorities, such as the Commission and to finding departments.

Lepra has a “zero tolerance” approach towards abuse, bullying, harassment, victimisation, discrimination, intimidation or exploitation of staff or beneficiaries.
